- Written by Robert Robinson in 1757 when he was 22 years old.
- Robinson, once a rebellious youth, was converted through the preaching of George Whitefield.
- The hymn reflects his gratitude for God's grace & a desire to remain faithful.

Love & Mercy

- God's Blessings

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

(James 1:17 ESV)

- Love & Mercy Never Ceasing

22 The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; 23 they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:22-23 ESV)

Love & Mercy

- Songs of Praise

1 Make a joyful noise to the Lord, all the earth! 2 Serve the Lord with gladness! Come into his presence with singing! (Psalm 100:1-2 ESV)

- Teach Me Worship

19 addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, (Ephesians 5:19 ESV)

Love & Mercy

- The Mount of Love

7 How precious is your steadfast love, O God! The children of mankind take refuge in the shadow of your wings. (Psalm 36:7 ESV)

The Stone of Help

- Ebenezer's Meaning

*12 Then Samuel took a stone and set it up between Mizpah and Shen and called its name Ebenezer; for he said, "Till now the Lord has helped us."
(1 Samuel 7:12 ESV)*

The Stone of Help

- God's Guidance

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. 6 In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

(Proverbs 3:5-6 ESV)

- Rescue Through Jesus

10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.”

(Luke 19:10 ESV)

The Stone of Help

- The Precious Blood

7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, (Ephesians 1:7 ESV)

- Assurance of Arrival

6 And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. (Philippians 1:6 ESV)

Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing

*Oh, to grace how great a debtor
Daily I'm constrained to be!
Let Thy goodness, like a fetter,
Bind my wandering heart to Thee.
Prone to wander, Lord, I feel it,
Prone to leave the God I love;

Seal it for Thy courts above*

Salvation

- Debtors to Grace

14 For sin will have no dominion over you, since you are not under law but under grace. (Romans 6:14 ESV)

- God's Goodness

*4 Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?
(Romans 2:4 ESV)*

Salvation

- Wandering Hearts

6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned - every one - to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all. (Isaiah 53:6 ESV)

- God's Sealing Work

13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, (Ephesians 1:13 ESV)

Salvation

- Eternal Home

*3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying,
“Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will
dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God
himself will be with them as their God.*

(Revelation 21:3 ESV)

Practical Applications

- Reflect on God's mercies daily with gratitude.
- Remember and celebrate God's help in your life.
- Pray for faithfulness when facing temptation.
- Share Christ's love and redemption with others.
- Focus on God through hymns and meditation.
- Dedicate your heart to God every day.
