

All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name

- Hymn was written by Edward Perronet, an English clergyman & poet, in the late 18th century
- Perronet, though raised in the Anglican Church, often found himself at odds with the establishment
- He was closely associated with John & Charles Wesley, prominent leaders in the Methodist movement
- This hymn, sometimes called the "National Anthem of Christendom," has been a rallying cry for Christians, expressing adoration & reverence for Christ's sovereignty

Heavenly Worship

- All angels are called to worship Jesus, affirming His divine authority

*6 And again, when he brings the firstborn into the world, he says, “Let all God's angels worship him.”
(Hebrews 1:6 ESV)*

Heavenly Worship

- Angels are commanded to praise God, recognizing His power in creation

*Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his hosts! 3
Praise him, sun and moon, praise him, all you shining
stars! 4 Praise him, you highest heavens, and you waters
above the heavens! 5 Let them praise the name of the
Lord! For he commanded and they were created
(Psalm 148:2-5 ESV)*

Heavenly Worship

- Angels surround the heavenly throne, praising the Lamb who is worthy of all honor & power

11 Then I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice, “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!”
(Revelation 5:11-12 ESV)

Heavenly Worship

- When Jesus returns every knee will bow, acknowledging His Lordship

*9 Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
(Philippians 2:9-11 ESV)*

Heavenly Worship

- Jesus' name is above all powers & dominions, confirming His ultimate authority

21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and above every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come.

(Ephesians 1:21 ESV)

*Let every tongue and every tribe
responsive to his call,
to him all majesty ascribe,
and crown Him Lord of all.
To Him all majesty ascribe,
and crown Him Lord of all!*

United in Crist

- People from every nation & language will stand before the Lamb, a testament to Christ's global authority & salvation

9 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 10 and crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!" (Revelation 7:9-10 ESV)

United in Crist

- All ends of the earth will turn to the Lord, acknowledging His kingdom

27 All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations shall worship before you. 28 For kingship belongs to the Lord, and he rules over the nations. (Psalm 22:27-28 ESV)

United in Crist

- Jesus commissioned His disciples to make disciples of all nations, a call for global worship

19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (Matthew 28:19 ESV)

United in Christ

- In Christ, all are unified, regardless of background, fulfilling God's inclusive purpose for redemption

28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave[a] nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. (Galatians 3:28 ESV)

Grace Saves

- Believers are a chosen people, called to declare the praises of Christ who has redeemed them

9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Peter 2:9 ESV)

Grace Saves

- Israel will be saved, part of God's covenant promises fulfilled in Christ

26 And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written, “The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob”; (Romans 11:26 ESV)

Grace Saves

- If we belong to Christ, we are heirs of Abraham, sharing in the promises

*29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.
(Galatians 3:29 ESV)*

Grace Saves

- The promise to Abraham extends to all nations through Christ, offering blessing & salvation

3 I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.” (Genesis 12:3 ESV)

Grace Saves

- Redemption through Christ's blood offers forgiveness, reaffirming our salvation


7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace, (Ephesians 1:7 ESV)

Practical Applications

- Regularly reflect on the majesty & power of Jesus' name, seeking to honor Him in all areas of life
- Set aside time each day to worship Jesus for His sovereignty and lordship
- Share the message of Jesus' redemptive power with those who haven't heard, fulfilling His call to all nations
- Pray in the powerful name of Jesus, trusting in His authority & intercession
