- People pleaser characteristics
 - Celebrate & respect differences in culture, ethnicity, gender & background, recognizing the value of diverse perspectives & experiences
 - Prioritize understanding & supporting others, showing genuine care & consideration for the wellbeing of those around them

- People pleaser characteristics (cont.)
 - Mindful of their impact on the planet, actively seeking sustainable practices & advocating for environmental conservation & stewardship
 - Stand up against discrimination, inequality & injustice, working towards creating a fairer & more equitable society for all individuals, regardless of their background

- People pleaser characteristics (cont.)
 - Approach information with skepticism, critically evaluating sources & perspectives while remaining open to new ideas & constructive dialogue
 - Empower others by fostering inclusive environments where everyone feels valued, respected & heard, promoting collaboration & collective growth

- People pleaser characteristics (cont.)
 - Demonstrate resilience in the face of challenges, embracing change as an opportunity for personal & societal growth & adapting to new circumstances with flexibility & optimism
 - Prioritize continuous learning & self-improvement, seeking out opportunities for growth intellectually, emotionally & spiritually & encouraging others to do the same

- People pleaser characteristics (cont.)
 - Recognize their interconnectedness with the global community, taking responsibility for their actions on a global scale & actively engaging in efforts to address global issues such as poverty, conflict & health crises

 - Advocate for justice and righteousness, standing up for the oppressed & marginalized
 - Live with integrity & honesty, adhering to moral principles even when faced with temptation or adversity

 - Generous with their resources, time & talents,
 willingly sharing what they have to bless others
 - Unwavering faith & trust in God, relying on divine guidance & strength to navigate life's challenges
