## The Point

The cross was the end of a path that began with Jesus being fully submitted to the will of the Father.

## *Luke 23 ESV*

*44 It was now about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour, 45 while the sun's light failed. And the curtain of the temple was torn in two. 46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.*

## *Luke 23 ESV*

*47 Now when the centurion saw what had taken place, he praised God, saying, “Certainly this man was innocent!” 48 And all the crowds that had assembled for this spectacle, when they saw what had taken place, returned home beating their breasts. 49 And all his acquaintances and the women who had followed him from Galilee stood at a distance watching these things.*

# SURRENDERING TO GOD'S PLAN



## Surrendering to God's Plan

- As the Second Person of the Triune God, Jesus was in a perfect relationship with His Father
- Out of perfect love, the Father sent the Son on a rescue mission to save us
- In obedience, the Lord Jesus voluntarily surrendered to His Father's plan emptying Himself by becoming human
- The name Jesus means, "God saves"

## Fully Committed

- Committed from eternity past - Jesus willingly stood up from His throne & surrendered His entire being to the hands of the Father
- Committed to His Father's plan of salvation – Salvation through Jesus is the only way
- Committed in His teaching ministry – We do not need to add anything

## Fully Committed

- Committed to the Father in His pain & private prayer life
  - Our High Priest
  - Gethsemane – “Not My will”
- Committed to the Father on the cross – Fathers praying Psalm 31 over their children (*5 Into your hand I commit my spirit*)
- Committed to His last breath – “I’d rather have cancer & Jesus” (Bob)
