

# Galatians 2 (ESV)

11 But when Cephas came to Antioch, I opposed him to his face, because he stood condemned. 12 For before certain men came from James, he was eating with the Gentiles; but when they came he drew back and separated himself, fearing the circumcision party.13 And the rest of the Jews acted hypocritically along with him, so that even Barnabas was led astray by their hypocrisy.

# Galatians 2 (ESV)

14 But when I saw that their conduct was not in step with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas before them all, "If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?"



### Some Things Are Worth Fighting For

- Gospel Saved by grace through faith in Jesus
- Paul challenged Peter face-to-face for "twisting" the Gospel – Some things are worth fighting for
- Feared Judaizers ("Circumcision Party")
- Lead to comprise (sin) two-faced
  - Kosher
  - "Rib-eye with bacon" Rooftop vision at Cornelius' house



### **Progressive Sanctification**

- "God's not done with us yet"
- "We are a work in-progress"
- Peter's life was a series of highs & lows
  - Walking on water & sinking
  - "Rocky" & "devil"
  - Garden & courtyard
- Comparison with others is defeated by the Gospel We all need Jesus



## **Hypocrisy**

- Our daily life reflects our faith
- Hypocrisy Our life does not reflect our words (masks)
- Sunday friends Weekday friends
- God knows that none of us is perfect (sinners) & loves us anyway
- We need someone who loves us to hold us accountable

### Hypocrisy

- Where am I out of step with the Gospel?
  - Fear Not ruled by the Spirit
  - Hypocrite Not a person of integrity (2-faced)
  - Legalism Faith in Jesus is not enough
  - Pride Not perfect, but better than most
- Cannot hold non-believers to same standards
