- The hymn was written by an American minister & evangelist named Judson Van DeVenter in 1896.
- He penned this hymn during a time of deep spiritual reflection when he fully yielded to God's calling for his life.
- The music was composed by Winfield Weeden, who popularized the hymn through his musical ministry.
- The hymn's timeless message of complete surrender resonates with believers as a call to entrust every aspect of life to God.

Trust in Jesus

- Surrendering involves giving ourselves fully to God.

1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.

(Romans 12:1 ESV)

- Living daily in Jesus' presence reflects true discipleship.

23 And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow

me." (Luke 9:23 ESV)

Trust in Jesus

- Trusting Jesus is essential for spiritual fruitfulness.

4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. (John 15:4 ESV)

- Complete love & trust are foundational to surrender.

37 And he said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. (Matthew 22:37 ESV)

Trust in Jesus

- Living in God's presence brings joy & guidance.

11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore. (Psalm 16:11 ESV)

Worldly Pleasures

- Humility is key to surrender.

10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you. (James 4:10 ESV)

- Forsaking worldly pleasures aligns with this mindset.

*8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ.
(Philippians 3:8 ESV)*

Worldly Pleasures

- True discipleship demands complete surrender.

33 So therefore, any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple. (Luke 14:33 ESV)

- Surrender means readiness to serve.

8 And I heard the voice of the Lord saying, “Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?” Then I said, “Here I am! Send me.” (Isaiah 6:8 ESV)

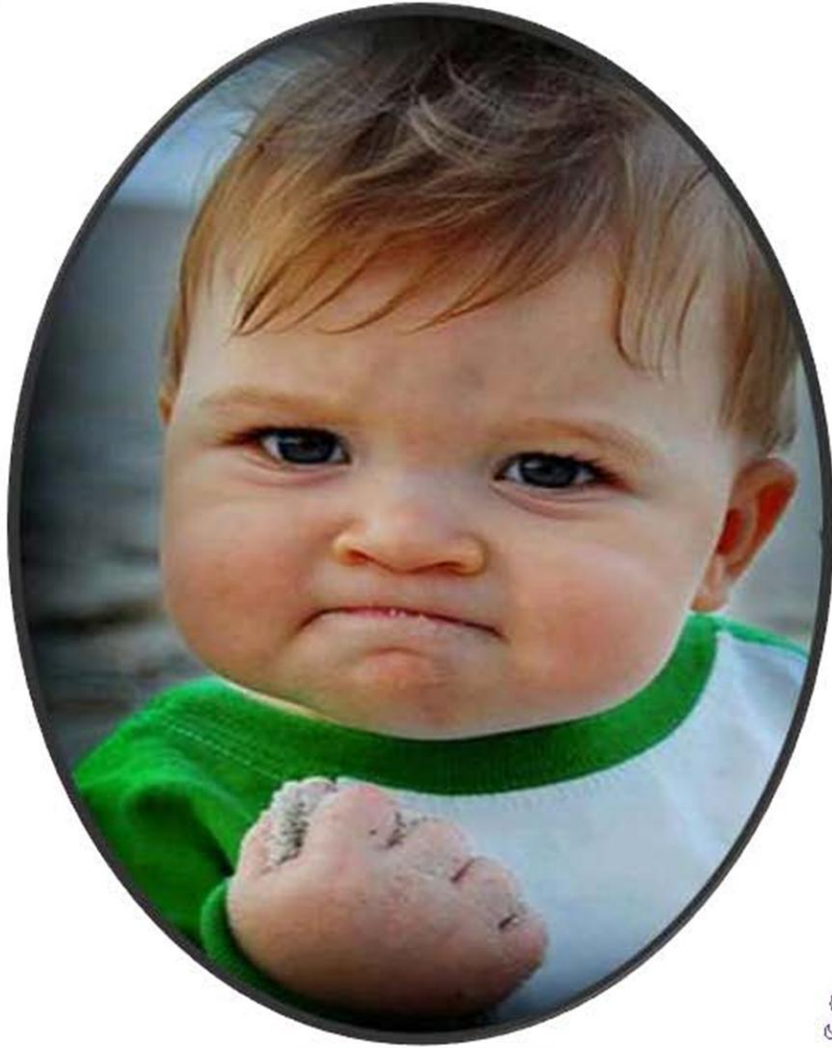
Worldly Pleasures

- Bowing at Jesus' feet signifies reverence & submission.

*6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel
before the Lord, our Maker! (Psalm 95:6 ESV)*

I Belong to Jesus

- Surrender results in belonging wholly to Christ.

20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. (Galatians 2:20 ESV)

I Belong to Jesus

- The Holy Spirit confirms our belonging to Jesus.

26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

(John 14:26 ESV)

- The Holy Spirit confirms our belonging to Jesus.

16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, (Romans 8:16 ESV)

I Belong to Jesus

- Wholeness involves God's transformative work.

23 Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! 24 And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!
(Psalm 139:23-24 ESV)

I Belong to Jesus

- The Holy Spirit seals believers as God's possession.

13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory. (Ephesians 1:13-14 ESV)

Practical Applications

- Make surrendering your plans & concerns to God a part of your daily prayer life.
- Release any unforgiveness, trusting God's justice & mercy.
- Seek ways to serve others as an act of surrender to God's will.
- Trust God with areas of life you find hard to release.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to guide your decisions & strengthen your faith daily.
